Why should we study prophecy?

One day, Jesus Christ, the King of kings, will return to establish His Eternal Kingdom and reign.

- A. The appearance of the Antichrist (Daniel 7:8; Revelation 13:1).
 - 1. An inconspicuous beginning.
 - 2. An intimidating beast.
- B. The <u>acclaim</u> of the Antichrist (<u>Revelation 13:3-4</u>).
 - 1. The <u>cause</u> of his acclaim: a <u>counterfeit</u> resurrection.
 - 2. The <u>character</u> of his acclaim: a <u>conquering</u> hero.
- C. The <u>audacity</u> of the Antichrist (Revelation 13:5-8, 11-17).
- D. The <u>authority</u> of Christ the King (<u>Revelation 19:19-20</u>; <u>20:10</u>)

How should we anticipate Christ's coming? (Revelation 13:10, 18)

- 1. Endurance keep working for Christ's Kingdom (Luke 19:12–13).
- 2. Faithfulness keep watching for Christ's Return (Matthew 25:13).
- 3. Wisdom keep waiting on Christ's Promises (2 Peter 3:9).
