**Ephesians 4:31–32** (CSB) <sup>31</sup> Let all bitterness, anger and wrath, shouting and slander be removed from you, along with all malice. <sup>32</sup> And be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving one another, just as God also forgave you in *Christ*.

- 5. Forgiveness \_\_\_\_\_\_ in the personal application of God's grace (<u>Matthew 18:23-35</u>).

**Colossians 3:12–13** (CSB) <sup>12</sup> Therefore, as God's chosen ones, holy and dearly loved, put on compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience, <sup>13</sup> bearing with one another and forgiving one another if anyone has a grievance against another. Just as the Lord has forgiven you, so you are also to forgive.

**Matthew 26:26–28** (CSB) <sup>26</sup> As they were eating, Jesus took bread, blessed and broke it, gave it to the disciples, and said, "Take and eat it; this is my body." <sup>27</sup> Then he took a cup, and after giving thanks, he gave it to them and said, "Drink from it, all of you. <sup>28</sup> For this is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins.
